DOG REGISTRATION

As a responsible and caring dog owner, it is important to register your dog with the City of Chicago. In the event your dog strays, the finder can call the City Clerk's Office at **312-742-5375** with the dog registration number on the tag and we will help reunite you with your dog.

A portion of your dog registration fee is allocated to Animal Care and Control and spay/neuter programs. The cost to register your dog is **\$5.00** for a sterilized dog (**\$2.50** for seniors) or **\$50.00** for an unsterilized dog (**\$5.00** for seniors).

You can register your dog at all City Clerk Office locations, online at www.ezbuy.chicityclerk.com, or call **312-744-DOGS (3647)** to have an application mailed to you.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ?

Q1. How much does it cost to register my dog?

A. The cost to register your dog with the City of Chicago for one year is; **\$5.00** for a sterilized dog (**\$2.50** for senior dog owners), **\$50.00** for an unsterilized dog (**\$5.00** for senior dog owners). View the table on page 6 for pricing.

Q2. Why do licenses for unsterilized dogs cost more?

A. Chicago's Animal Care & Control is forced to house, care for, and even euthanize, thousands of animals each year. This tragic and costly reality could be reduced by spaying and neutering your dog. Sterilized dogs are healthier, have fewer medical problems and are less likely to run away or fight with other animals.

Q3. When does my dog's registration expire?

A. Your dog's registration expires on either the registration expiration date (i.e. 1 or 3 years after purchase, depending on the length you purchase) or the expiration date of its current rabies vaccination, whichever comes first. Since rabies vaccinations typically last either one or three years (depending on the vaccination administered by your dog's vet), the Clerk's Office offers dog registration in 1-year and 3-year increments.

Q4. What do I need to register my dog?

A. All Chicago dogs older than four months are required to be registered with the City Clerk's Office. All Chicago dogs must have a current rabies vaccination and you may use your rabies vaccination paperwork to complete the license application. Ordering your dog license online at **www.EzBuy.ChiCityClerk.com** is the easiest way to go. To expedite the issuance of your dog license, visit a City Clerk's Office location in-person.

DOG REGISTRATION BENEFITS

HELP WITH A LOST DOG

Your registration can help find your lost dog. The person who finds your dog can simply call the Office of the City Clerk at **312-744-DOGS (3647)** and provide the dog registration number, which appears on your dog license tag. We can put City resources to work to help reunite you with your lost dog.

ACCESS TO DOG-FRIENDLY IN OUTDOOR CAFES

Dog owners who enjoy dining at outdoor cafes are permitted to bring their dog with them to restaurants that are licensed appropriately. See page 20 for a list of dog-friendly outdoor cafés.

ACCESS TO DOG-FRIENDLY STORES

Leashed, well behaved dogs are allowed in stores. See page 22 for a list of dog-friendly stores.

DOGGY DAYCARE

Your dog registration is required when taking your dog to a Chicago animal care facility that boards or provides dog daycare services. See page 24 for a list of dog daycare services.

ACCESS TO CITY DOG PARKS AND BEACHES

Dog friendly areas are designated sections within Chicago parks or beaches, where dogs are allowed to run and play off-leash, the only areas in the city where this is allowed. The owner or other person bringing any dog into a dog friendly area must have a permit and tag issued by a veterinarian for each dog. See page 30 for a list of dog parks and beaches.

PUBLIC HEALTH

Dog registration helps protect the public and your dog. When you register your dog and display your license, you let the public know that your dog has received its rabies vaccination and that it is in compliance with County and City regulations.

The Animal Care and Control shelter is open daily from 12:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. for people to search for their lost dog. Photographs of stray dogs are posted online at 24petconnect.com/chgoall as soon as they arrive at the shelter. Typically stray dogs are scanned on arrival for a microchip, and checked for a dog license and/or rabies tag. An identifiable dog owner will be notified by mail or telephone. If an identified dog is not claimed by the owner within seven days, the dog becomes property of the City. If deemed adoptable, the dog may be offered for adoption at Animal Care and Control or transferred to another shelter or rescue group after three full viewing days at the shelter.

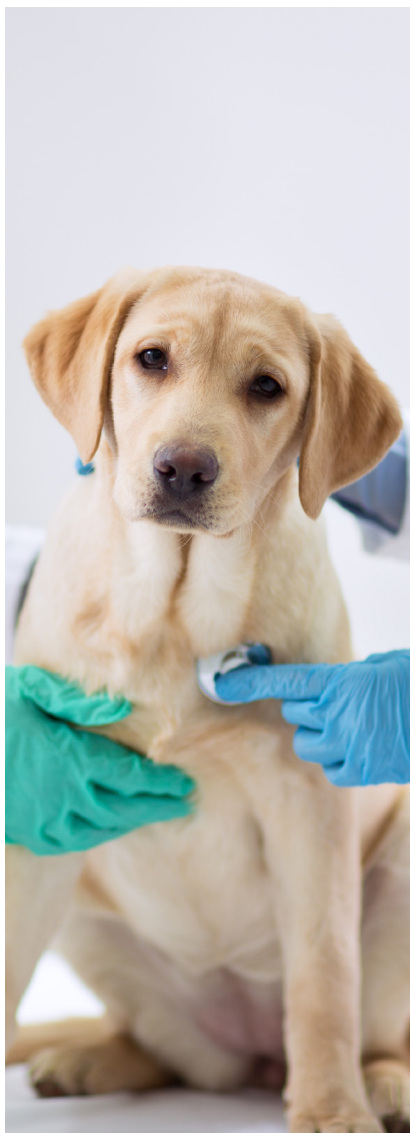

CHICAGO ANIMAL CARE AND CONTROL

Chicago Animal Care and Control (CACC) protects public safety and ensures the humane care of animals through sheltering, pet placement, education and animal law enforcement.

DOG LEASH IMPORTANCE

Even a well-trained, well-socialized dog needs supervision, instructions and boundaries.

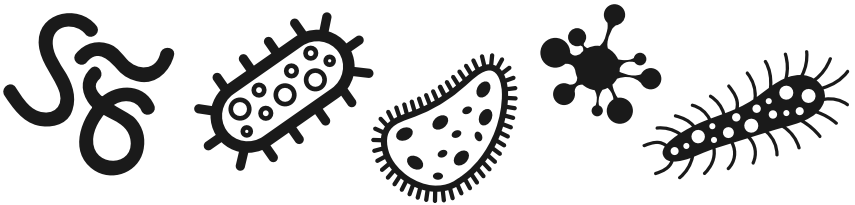


Here are some reasons why leashing your dog is so important:

- It prevents your dog from straying and getting lost.
- They protect your dog from darting into traffic to chase something.
- Leashes protect your dog from unseen or unknown hazards, such as things that cut, sting, bite or cause illness.
- They also prevent your dog from startling unsuspecting pedestrians nearby or from chasing or scaring other animals into traffic or harm's way.
- Leashes reduce the chance of your dog harming another person or dog. Whether the dog is startled, frightened or protecting their guardian, a dog has the potential to bite.
- Cleaning up after your dog is easier when they have a leash on.
- Some plants may be dangerous for dogs. Leashes direct your dog away from areas where plants should be preserved.
- Leashes reduce stress for your dog by making sure the dog understands what is expected. Less stress means a healthier and happier dog.
- A dog on a leash helps reduce the risk of the pain, suffering and guilt your family will go through if your dog gets lost, hurt or bites someone.
- Most importantly, it is the law per Municipal code 7-12-030. A base fine of **\$300.00** can be issued to an owner for having an unrestrained dog.

WHY YOU SHOULD PICK-UP AFTER YOUR PET

- Pet waste is unsightly and emits a foul odor.
- It runs off into the water system.
- Stepping in it is simply disgusting.
- Dogs can spread diseases to each other through their feces.
- It attracts rodents and other pests.
- The Removal of excrement is the law per Municipal Code 7-12-420 and you can receive up to a **\$500.00** fine.



Dog feces can carry diseases, that can infect humans including:

SALMONELLA which may cause an upset stomach or more severe problems.

ROUNDWORM potentially causes a mild rash to more serious diseases to the lungs or liver, or even blindness. The Center for Disease Control and Prevention reports 10,000 cases of roundworm infection annually.

HOOKWORM is a parasite that can be picked up by individuals that walk barefoot in contaminated areas.

CAMPYLOBACTERIOSIS is a bacterial infection that can cause diarrhea, cramps, fever, and vomiting in humans.

GIARDIASIS is a diarrheal illness caused by a one-celled, microscopic parasite. Once an animal or person has been infected, the parasite lives in the intestine and is passed in the stool. The parasite can survive outside of the body and in the environment for long periods of time because of its protection by an outer shell.

PREVENTING ANIMAL VIOLENCE

ANIMAL ABUSE

Animal abuse is a crime. Animal fighting (meaning two animals, such as dogs or roosters, pitted against each other by people, usually for human entertainment) is a felony. Always call **911** if you see animal abuse or fighting in progress. If you are suspicious of animal abuse or fighting, call **311**. You can remain anonymous in both of these situations. Additionally, you can submit an online Pet Wellness Check request on 311 by visiting **311.chicago.gov**

SAFE HUMANE CHICAGO

Safe Humane Chicago is a citywide, public and private partnership to stop animal violence in our city. It builds alliances among local government, animal and community advocates, humane organizations and the faith-based community. COOK COUNTY ANIMAL AND RABIES CONTROL

The Cook County Department of Animal & Rabies Control provides health protection to the residents of Cook County through preparation, education, rabies vaccination and stray animal control. Services they offer include a spay and neuter program, stray patrol, education, rabies tags, pet registration and a pet return service. CHICAGO DOG FRIENDLY AREA FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

The Chicago Park District Dog Friendly Areas (DFA) are places for dogs to exercise, play, and socialize legally off-leash in an enclosed area. A permit fee and registration tag for your dog is required. A current dog license can be used to obtain the required permit and tag to access a Chicago Park District DFA. Permits and tags are required and are available at participating veterinary offices. For a list of participating veterinarians, or if you are interested in creating a DFA in your community, please visit bit.ly/CPDDFA or call **312-742-PLAY (7529)**.

Q1. What is the permit and tag fee?

A. The permit and dog tag fee is a total of **\$10.00**.

Q2. How long is a permit and tag valid?

A. Any permit and registration tag will be valid only for a single season no matter when purchased. A single season is defined as the period running from January 1 of any year through December 31 of the same year.

Q3. Will there be a sliding scale for seniors or visitors?

A. There will not be a sliding scale. Visitors must follow the same procedures for obtaining a permit and tag.

Q4. Where can I get a permit and tag?

A. Permits and tags will only be available at participating Chicago veterinary offices. View a list of participating partners at bit.ly/CPDDFA. If you are an out of state resident you must also contact one of the participating Chicagoland veterinary offices to determine what paperwork is necessary to obtain the permit and tag. You should call them first to confirm that they will assist you and to determine how much they charge for an office visit. Also, you can have your own veterinarian purchase the tag on your behalf from the Chicago Park District by contacting **312-742-4687**.

Q5. Will there be visitor or day passes?

A. There are no visitor or day passes. Any visitor wishing to bring their pet to a DFA must follow the same procedures for obtaining a permit and tag.

Q6. What are the permit requirements?

- A.** Pursuant to regulations under the new Cook County Ordinance, dog owners must show proof of:
- a. Current dog license issued by the City of Chicago, or proof that the dog has a current rabies vaccination.
 - b. Examination within the past year for any communicable diseases including an examination of a stool specimen for internal parasites. Current vaccination or titer if possible for Distemper, Hepatitis, Para-influenza, Parvovirus, and Bordatella (kennel cough) unless an exemption to this requirement has been granted by the Administrator upon the written recommendation from the Owner's veterinarian.
 - c. The owner must complete a Chicago Park District Dog Friendly Area Permit Application for each dog and agree to abide by the Chicago Park District Rules and Regulations of a Dog Friendly Area.

Q7. Who will enforce the rules and regulations?

- A.** The Cook County Department of Animal and Rabies Control will enforce DFA rules and regulations and issue tickets to violators. Violators, along with the Chicago Park District, will face a possible fine of **\$500.00**. Dog owners must carry their permits at all times when attending DFAs. Each DFA will have a sign posted at the entrance stating all DFA rules and regulations.

Q8. What happens if I lose my permit or tag?

- A.** If a patron loses their dog tag or permit, they must reapply for a permit and tag for a **\$5.00** fee with a participating veterinarian, or if the veterinarian has proof of purchase, the park district will supply a replacement tag.

Q9. Why do I need a permit and tag for my dog to enter a DFA?

- A.** Pursuant to a regulation issued by the Administrator of the Cook County Department of Animal and Rabies Control, all dogs entering a DFA must have a permit and registration tag from a licensed veterinarian. People bring dogs into a DFA must have both a permit with them and a registration tag for each dog. The registration tag must be on the dog's collar or harness. The permit and registration tag may be used at any officially sanctioned DFA. The tag helps other users of the dog friendly areas be comfortable knowing your dog is healthy and vice-versa you to see that their dog is healthy.

RULES & REGULATIONS OF CHICAGO PARK DISTRICT DFA

- Dog owners are legally responsible for their dogs and any injuries caused by their dogs.
- Dog owners must remain with and watch their dogs at all times.
- Dogs must be leashed prior to and upon leaving the Dog Friendly Area (DFA). Gates to the DFAs must remain closed, except upon entering and exiting.
- Dog owners must immediately clean up after their dogs. Dog owners who fail to clean up after their dogs are subject to a fine of up to **\$500.00** (City of Chicago Ordinance 7-12-420).
- Dogs with a history of, or who exhibit, exhibiting dangerous behavior are prohibited.
- Dogs must be healthy, fully immunized, dewormed, licensed and compliant with the Cook County Department of Animal and Rabies Control Regulation for dog friendly areas.
- No dogs will be allowed in a DFA without a current rabies vaccination.
- Puppies under four months old and female dogs in heat are prohibited.
- Dog owners are responsible for the monitoring and maintenance of the DFA.
- Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult, and younger children must be closely supervised.
- Only three dogs per person are allowed in a DFA.
- No food (human or dog food) is allowed inside the DFA.
- Failure to comply with the Cook County Department of Animal and Rabies Control Regulation for DFAs can result in a fine of up to **\$500.00**.
- Dog owners or other responsible persons must have a DFA permit with them for each dog visiting the DFA.
- DFA permits are valid January 1 through December 31 each year.

CHICAGO DOG FRIENDLY AREA SUPPORT GROUPS

Dog owners are responsible for the monitoring and maintenance of the DFA. Chicago Park District policy is for each dog park to have a local support committee that handles all the maintenance and community engagement at the park.

Neighborhood residents from local support committees selflessly volunteer their time and effort to ensure a safe and clean environment for dogs and their owners. You can help by joining a DFA support group, volunteering, or establishing a support committee for a DFA that does not already have one.

LIST OF CHICAGO DOG FRIENDLY OUTDOOR DINING

Dog owners who enjoy dining at outdoor cafes are permitted to bring their dog with them to restaurants that are licensed appropriately. Restaurants wishing to participate must apply for a City issued permit and are required to post a sign in a visible location stating that dogs are allowed in the outdoor dining area. Customers must have the dog's vaccination tags or proof of vaccinations. Dogs are not allowed on the table, countertop or similar surface, and employees may not touch the dog for sanitary reasons. Remember to feed your dog before you go to dine, as food cannot be provided to your dog while in the outdoor dining area. In addition, your dog must be on a leash and on its best behavior.

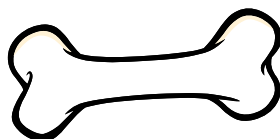

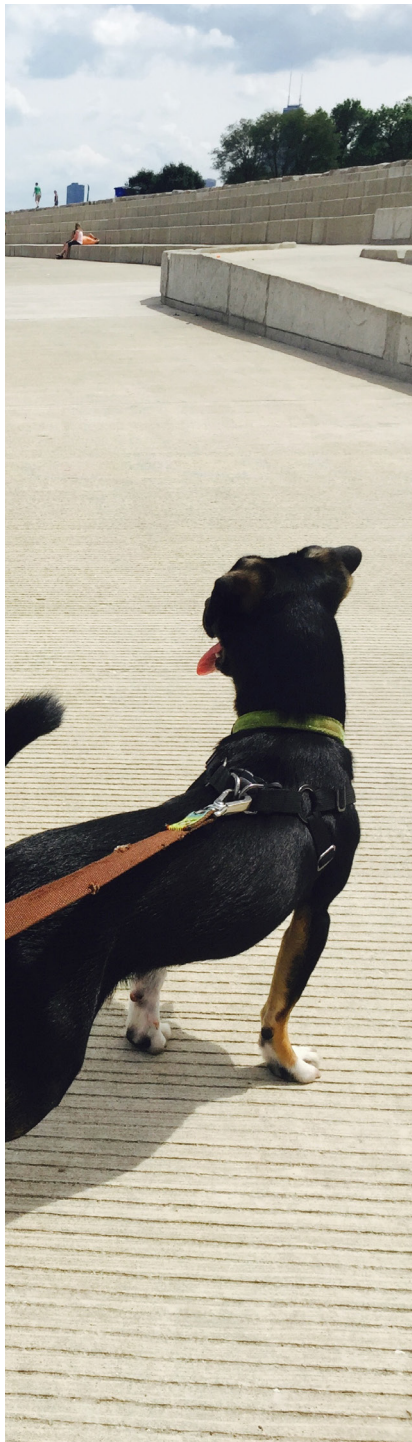
