Chairperson Rodriguez called the committee meeting to order at approximately 12:52 pm. The Chair then proceeded to call for a roll call to establish quorum. After establishing a quorum, the Chairperson called for a vote to allow remote participation for Ald. Ramirez, Ald. Yancy, Ald. Robinson, Ald. Coleman, and Ald. Taliaferro. Ald. Manaa-Hoppenworth moved to approve remote participation of these Alderpeople and was approved by voice vote with no nays or abstentions. The public comment period began with 3 minutes allotted to each speaker.

There were five public speakers that submitted pink slips and three written comments.

**The committee heard public comment from the following speakers:**

Jessica Jackson, George Blakemore and Natasha Gray and Tiwon Sims.

Following public comments, Chairperson Rodriguez passed it to Chairperson Rodriguez-Sanchez who called the first and only item on the agenda:

- **O2024-0007340- An Amendment of the Municipal Code Title 2 by adding new Sections 2-50-045 and 2-112-205 regarding definitions and terms of health and social services contracts with the City of Chicago.**

Chairperson Rodriguez-Sanchez called for the adoption of Substitute Ordinance **SO2024-0007340**, and moved by Ald. Gutierrez, the motion passed.

Ald. Villegas presented the substitute ordinance and provided information about the changes made to the ordinance.


Chairperson Rodriguez-Sanchez opened the space for Q&A:

- Ald. Ramirez-Rosa commented on the importance of ensuring protection for workers at the City delegate agencies
- Ald. Hadden commented to reiterate her support for this ordinance and the need for more protections for workers in delegate agencies.
- Chairperson Rodriguez-Sanchez asked why is it important to pass this?
  - Kyle Campbell from AFSCME Associate General Counsel responded that these amendments seek to ensure the non-interruption of essential services, so the residents of the City of Chicago can continue to receive services from the City's delegate agencies.

Chairperson Rodriguez called for a motion to approve the substitute ordinance **SO2024-0007340**, so moved by Ald. Chico, it passed unanimously.

The Committee having no further business, on a motion made by Ald. Hadden, the meeting was adjourned.
