COMMITTEE ON WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT MONTHLY RULE 45 REPORT JUNE 3rd 2024

Pursuant to Rule 45 of the City Council Rules of Order, the Committee on Workforce Development submits the following Monthly Rule 45 Report for Monday, June 3rd 2024.

Date, Time & Location of Meeting: On Monday, June 3rd 2024 at 1pm in City Council Chambers.

Member Attendance: The following members were present: Chairperson Rodriguez (22), Vice Chairperson Gutierrez (14), Alderman Yancy (5), Alderman Chico (10), Alderwoman Ramirez (12), Alderman Quinn (13), Alderman Coleman (16), Alderman Taliaferro (29), Alderman Ramirez-Rosa (35), Alderman Sposato (38), Alderperson Vasquez (40), Alderwoman Clay (46)

Non-Member Attendance: Alderman O'Shea (19), Alderwoman Manaa-Hoppenworth (48)

Chairperson Rodriguez called the meeting to order at 1:10pm. There were six items on the Agenda.

- 1) Approval of April 11th Rule 45 Report
- 2) A2024-0009549 – Appointment of Abbey Eusebio as member of Human Resources Board
- 3) A2024-0009550 – Appointment of Dominique Jordan Turner as member of Human Resources Board
- 4) A2024-0009551 – Appointment of Laurie J. Dittman as Chair and member of Human Resources Board
- 5) Direct Introduction – An ordinance authorizing the execution of a collective bargaining agreement between the Illinois Council of Police (Aviation Surveillance Specialists) and the City of Chicago
- 6) Direct Introduction – An ordinance authorizing the execution of a collective bargaining agreement between the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Local 700 (Supervising Police Communication Operators/SPCSOs) and the City of Chicago

Chairperson Rodriguez conducted a roll call to establish a quorum.

After determining a quorum existed of present members, the Chair asked that by Rule 59 the following Alders be allowed to participate by remote participation: Alderman Stephanie Coleman, Alderman Carlos Ramirez-Rosa, Alderman Vasquez and Alderwoman Clay. All members present voted in favor of a motion by Alderman Yancy to allow remote participation.

Chairperson Rodriguez then noted that there were four people who signed up for public comment.

The following members of the public spoke during public comment: Rachel Arfa spoke in favor of the appointments, Tiwon Sims spoke about human rights, George Blakemore spoke in opposition to the appointments, and Karina Kidder spoke in favor of the appointments.

Following public comment the Chair moved to the following Agenda items:

Agenda Item 1 – Rule 45 Report

Following public comment, the Chairperson moved on to the first item on the agenda, approval of the April 11th report. Alderperson Vasquez moved to accept the report and it was approved by a voice vote of the members present.

Agenda Item 2 – A2024-0009549

Chairperson Rodriguez acknowledged Abbey Eusebio and asked her to introduce herself to the Committee. After a short introduction the following Alders asked questions: Alderwoman Ramirez spoke of her relationship with the appointee. The Chair then asked for a motion to approve Abbey Eusebio's appointment, which was moved by Alderwoman Ramirez. This appointment was approved by a unanimous vote.

Agenda Item 3 - A2024-0009550

The Chairperson then asked for a short statement from Dominique Jordan Turner to introduce herself to the Committee. Following the introduction the Chair acknowledged Alderman O'Shea who spoke in support of Dominique's appointment, noting that several Mayor's have tapped the appointee to serve on various public boards. The Chair asked for a motion to approve the appointment, which was moved by Alderman Sposato and approved by a unanimous voice vote.

Agenda Item 4 - A2024-0009551

The Chairperson then asked for a statement from Laurie J. Dittman. Following her statement, the Chair opened up the floor for questions. Seeing no questions, the Chair asked for a motion to approve the appointment, which was moved by Alderwoman Gutierrez and approved by a unanimous voice vote.

Agenda Item 5 - Direct Introduction – An ordinance authorizing the execution of a collective bargaining agreement between the Illinois Council of Police (Aviation Surveillance Specialists) and the City of Chicago

The Chairperson then acknowledged Chief Labor Negotiator Cicely Porter who spoke about the employees covered by the ICOP agreement. Following a statement on the contract the Chair asked for a motion to approve the item, which was moved by Alderman Chico and approved by a unanimous voice vote.

Agenda Item 6 - Direct Introduction – An ordinance authorizing the execution of a collective bargaining agreement between the Internation Brotherhood of Teamsters, Local 700 (Supervising Police Communication Operators/SPCSOs) and the City of Chicago

The Chairperson then moved to Cicely Porter to explain the collective bargaining agreement with the Brotherhood of Teamsters Local 700. Following a short statement Alderman Taliaferro asked about how the agreement aligns with other bargaining units' contracts. The Chair then asked for a motion to approve item 6 on the agenda, which was provided by Alderman Taliaferro and approved by a unanimous voice vote.

Following the approval of the final agenda item, the Chair asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Vice Chair Gutierrez so moved, and the meeting adjourned at 2pm.
