**COMMITTEE ON POLICE AND FIRE
MONTHLY RULE 45 REPORT
July, 2024**

Pursuant to Rule 45 of the City Council Rules of Order, the Committee on Police and Fire submits the following monthly report.

On Monday, July 15th, 2024, at 1:10 p.m., The Committee on Police and Fire called the meeting to order, pursuant to applicable law, the Chairman determined that remote participation was allowed in case of emergency, per the aldermen that requested. Accordingly, attendance at this meeting was in City Council Chambers, with some members participating virtually.

The following members were present: Hall (6), Mitchell (7), Lee (11), Curtis (18), Tabares (23), Ervin (28), Cardona (31), Sposato (38), Nugent (39), Napolitano (41), Knudsen (43), Silverstein (50), and Chairman Taliaferro (29).

The following members participated by remote means: Vice-Chair Robinson (4), Taylor (20), Mosley (21), Gardiner (45), and Clay (46).

The following non-members were present: Rodriguez (22), Burnett (27), Cruz (30), Vasquez (40), Manaa-Hoppenworth (48), Hadden (49),

Chairman Taliaferro called the meeting to order at 1:10 pm. The Chairman Taliaferro instructed protocol to be used in the forum. Roll Call was taken and a quorum was established. The following members requested remote participation; Vice-Chair Robinson (4), Taylor (20), Mosley (21), Gardiner (45), and Clay (46). The motion to let the members participate remotely was so moved by Alderman Curtis. The Chairman opened the floor for public comments. The following public speakers were each allowed 3 minutes to speak; Tiwon Sims, Mrs. Lawrence, Doris Lewis, Michael Young-Bay, Zoe Leigh, Charles Spence, Jessica Jackson, George Blakemore, and Theresa "TJ" Hughes. Public speaking was concluded.

Alderman Cardona moved to approve the Rule 45 Monthly Report for June 2024, there were no objections, and the motion was ordered based on the affirmative vote of all members present for the roll call used to determine a quorum.

Chairman Christopher Taliaferro introduced the agenda item before the committee. The Chairman introduced appointee, Angel Rubi Navarajo, and allowed him to make an opening remark. The Chairman introduced the representative from the City of Chicago's law department, Kristopher Kolb, Assistant Corporation Counsel. Mr. Kolb addressed the Chairman's concerns and provided testimony for the body. The Chairman then opened the floor for questions from members and non-members. The following committee members and non-members provided comments and questions to the appointee, Alderwoman Nugent, Alderwoman Lee, Alderman Curtis, Alderman Napolitano, and Alderman Ervin. Alderwoman Lee made a motion to hold the item. Alderman Vasquez made a Point of Information. The line of questioning continued with Alderman Cardona, Alderman Napolitano, Alderman Rodriguez, Alderman Nugent, and Alderman Vasquez. Seeing no further questions, Chairman Taliaferro requested a roll call vote on the motion to hold the item in committee.
