WHEREAS, Unsafe, unattractive and bothersome conditions on railroad property are a continuing source of frustration for Chicago residents and for their aldermen, who on a daily basis field many complaints from residents upset by overgrown vegetation on railroad property, unreasonably long obstructions of crossings at grade, delayed access to emergency services at such crossings, excessive train idling, diesel fuel emissions and other problems; and

WHEREAS, Chicago is the most important railroad center in North America. More lines of track radiate in more directions from Chicago than from any other city in the United States. Chicago is the hub of our Nation's freight network, and ranks second only to New York City with respect to the volume of commuter rail passengers carried each day. Rail lines cross roadways at numerous points in Chicago, and are an integral and visible part of our communities; and

WHEREAS, Due to the number, type and scope of various Federal and State preemptions that restrict the ability of local municipalities to regulate rail carriers by ordinance, Chicagoans are at the mercy of railroad companies, and the Federal and State administrative bodies charged with responsibility for overseeing them, to ensure that railroad property is properly maintained; that railroad crossings do not block vehicular and pedestrian traffic for unreasonably long periods of time; that locomotives spend as little time as possible idling; and that the noise produced by trains does not constantly disrupt the peace and tranquility of surrounding neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, At the Federal level, rail carriers are governed by several statutes, the bulk of which are administered by the U.S. Secretary of Transportation through various regulatory bodies, including the Federal Railroad Safety Act, administered through the Federal Railroad Administration; Hazardous Material Transportation Act (HMTA), administered through the Pipeline and Hazardous Material Safety Administration (PHMSA); Railroad Revitalization and Regulatory Reform Act and Rail Passenger Service Act, to name but a few. The Interstate Commerce Commission Termination Act, administered through the Surface Transportation Board, provides broad and extensive regulation of the activities of freight railroads operating in interstate commerce. In addition, because locomotives spend a substantial amount of time idling, the United States Environmental Protection Agency regulates diesel line-haul and passenger and switch locomotives, with a view toward reducing the time during which locomotives emit harmful pollutants, consume fuel and make noise; and

WHEREAS, In Illinois, the Illinois Commercial Transportation Law gives the Illinois Commerce Commission "exclusive power" to regulate rail carriers in Illinois and "all intrastate and interstate rail carrier operations within this State, except to the extent that its jurisdiction is preempted by . . . valid federal statute, regulation or order"; and



WHEREAS, Because this complex web of Federal and State preemptions makes it virtually impossible for the City of Chicago to regulate railroads in any meaningful way, it is incumbent upon Federal and State authorities to actively monitor the activities of railroads, in light of the very real needs and concerns of local residents, to ensure that the railroads are in compliance with all applicable laws, and to routinely undertake a systematic review of existing laws for the purpose of determining whether, in various areas, those laws should be modified to hold railroads to a higher standard of accountability to local residents than is currently the case; and

WHEREAS, There is no good reason why railroad property should be allowed to deteriorate to the point of blighting entire neighborhoods. Large weeds, frequently in excess of 15 inches in height, rusted and broken fencing, damaged lighting, graffiti and garbage strewn railroad viaducts, and inadequate rodent control on railroad property are commonplace. The urban landscape is being ruined and average citizens are suffering from an inability to enjoy life in their own homes and neighborhoods. Shielded by laws containing exceptionally broad preemptions covering every conceivable subject matter, railroads have no incentive whatsoever to address the legitimate concerns of local residents and, as a result, have become increasingly arrogant and unwilling to work with local governmental leaders to help solve the simplest of problems; and

WHEREAS, Our citizens deserve better. These conditions are unacceptable and should not be tolerated by the governmental entities charged with railroad oversight. An economically viable national railroad system should not come completely at the expense of quality of life in our Nation's communities; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, That we, the Mayor and Members of the City Council of the City of Chicago, assembled this fourteenth day of October, 2015, do hereby urge Congress and the Illinois General Assembly to take appropriate action to ensure that railroads are sufficiently regulated or otherwise incentivized, including through the vigorous application of monetary penalties, to ameliorate nuisance conditions on their property and in connection with railroad operations; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Clerk be directed to provide suitable copies of this resolution to the President pre tempore of the Senate and Speaker of the House of Representatives of the Congress of the United States, to each member of the Illinois congressional delegation, to the U.S. Secretary of Transportation; and to the Chairman of the Illinois Commerce Commission, as a sign of our concern for this important issue.

ORDINANCE



PROPERTY TAX INCREASE AND TAX RELIEF PROGRAM 2015

WHEREAS, the City of Chicago is facing a massive budget shortfall in four pension plans and a pension deficit of up to \$550 million that must be paid December 2015; and

WHEREAS, in 2014, the City collected \$824 million in property taxes and roughly \$478 million went to payments for the four city pension funds: Police, Fire, Municipal, and Laborers; and

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2015, Moody's Investors Service announced it lowered the City of Chicago's credit rating to non-investment, or junk bond, status as a result of unfunded pension obligations; and

WHEREAS, there is a dire need for additional revenue to fulfill pension debt obligations; and

WHEREAS, by not funding pension liabilities, the debt will continue to grow and affect Chicago's fiscal operations and impact expenditures for critical areas such as education, public welfare, and infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, to fulfill obligations Chicago must raise additional revenue to address the city's financial liabilities; and

WHEREAS, increasing the property tax rate in the City may provide the financial soundness to pay for the city's fiscal obligations; and

WHEREAS, working families are already financially burdened and a significant property tax increase could harm them substantially; and

WHEREAS, to ease this burden the City will provide temporary property tax relief assistance to the hardest hit households: and

WHEREAS, in order to assist low and middle income families negatively affected by a property tax increase, the City of Chicago will institute a Property Tax Relief Program; **NOW**, **THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The above recitals are expressly incorporated herein and made part hereof as though fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2. Chapter 2-32 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is amended by adding a new Section 2-32-627 as follows:

2-32-627 Property tax relief program.

(a) As used in this Section:

"Applicable year" means the calendar year for which a Homeowner has received a final real estate tax bill that exceeds the final real estate tax bill for the immediately preceding year;

"Assessed value" means the equalized assessed value set for Real estate tax purposes, as determined by the Office of the Cook County Assessor or the Cook County Board of Review;

"Base City's real estate tax assessment rate" is the fraction of the levy for the immediately preceding taxable year divided by the current taxable year's equalized assessed value, which when multiplied by the Equalized Assessed value of a property would determine the amount of money a Homeowner would pay for their portion of City of Chicago real estate taxes absent a change in the tax levy.

"Chief Financial Officer" means the Chief Financial Officer of the City of Chicago or his or her designee.

"City's real estate tax assessment rate" is that fraction which is multiplied by the Assessed value of the property to determine the amount of money the Homeowner must pay for his City of Chicago portion of his Real estate taxes.

"Eligible Homeowner" means a Homeowner who has adjusted gross income in the applicable year under \$100,000.

"Homeowner" means an individual who, at the time of the application and since January 1 of the calendar year immediately preceding the applicable year: (i) is the owner of record of or has a legal or equitable interest, except for a leasehold interest that is not a residential cooperative, in property in this city that is used by the individual as the individual's principal place of residence; and (ii) is liable for paying the Real estate taxes on the property. For purposes of the definition of "homeowner," an equitable interest shall include a beneficial interest in property that is held in an Illinois land trust;

"Household" means the Homeowner, the spouse of the Homeowner if the spouse filed a joint federal income tax return with the Homeowner for the applicable year, and all persons using the residence of the Homeowner as their principal place of residence;

"Household income" means the combined income of the members of a Household

for the applicable year;

"Real estate taxes" means the taxes on real property for which a Homeowner is liable under the Property Tax Code, 35 ILCS 200/1-1 et seq.; and

"Real estate tax increase" means the amount by which the total Real estate taxes payable in the applicable year exceeds the total Real estate taxes payable in the immediately preceding taxable year.

- (b) The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish and administer a property tax relief program under this section for the purpose of providing assistance to certain Homeowners whose Real estate tax liability has significantly risen, particularly relative to their Household incomes as provided in this section. Under this program, a Homeowner who meets the eligibility requirements for a grant under this section may receive a grant in the amount specified in this section. A Homeowner shall be eligible for a grant under this section for that portion of an increase in taxes attributable to an increase in the tax rate assessed for the City of Chicago, and not for that portion attributable to either an increase in assessed value or an increase in tax rate of another taxing body.
- (c) The relief the Homeowner is entitled to would be calculated as follows:
 - 1. Start with 100,000 and subtract Household income
 - 2. Take this result and divide by 100,000 to get the rebate rate
 - 3. Multiply the rebate rate times the difference between the City's Real estate tax assessment rate for the applicable year and the City's Base real estate tax assessment rate.
 - 4. Multiply this number by the Assessed value.
- (c)(1) Additional relief will be provided to a Homeowner who is 60 years of age or older, who has resided in their household for 18 years or longer, and whose assessed value has increased by 30% or more from the prior tax year. Homeowners who are eligible for the Senior Citizens Assessment Freeze homestead exemption or the Homestead Improvement Exemption are not eligible for this relief. This additional relief would be calculated as follows:
 - Subtract the percentage increase of total equalized assessed value for the City of Chicago from the percentage increase in the homeowner's equalized assessed value to get the Long Term Homeowner supplemental relief rate
 - 2. Multiply this supplemental relief rate by the difference between the City's Real estate tax assessment rate for the applicable year and the City's Base real estate tax assessment rate
 - 3. Multiply this number by the Equalized Assessed Value.
 - 4. Add this amount to the relief provided under Section (c) to determine the total amount of relief.
- (d) A Homeowner must file an application to participate in the relief program with the Department of Finance. The application must be on a form prescribed by the Chief

Financial Officer and include evidence of the Homeowner's Household income for the applicable year, evidence that the applicant became the Homeowner prior to January 1st of the calendar year immediately preceding the applicable year, evidence of the amount of the Homeowner's Real estate tax increase.

- (e) The provisions of Section 2-156-110 of this Code does not apply to City employees with respect to their participation in the property tax relief program created pursuant to this section.
- (f) The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend legally available funds for the implementation of this section. However, the program created pursuant to this section will be suspended at any time that no funds are legally available for the program. The Chief Financial Officer also is authorized to enter into agreements and execute documents necessary to implement this section, to promulgate rules and regulations necessary to implement this section and to prescribe application forms and other forms necessary to elicit relevant information concerning participants in the property tax relief program. The Chief Financial Officer may request the Office of Compliance to conduct audits to determine eligibility of an applicant to participate in the property tax relief program created pursuant to this section. Any personal financial information provided to the City in connection with an application submitted under this section shall remain confidential.

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CITY OF CHICAGO EQUAL ACCESS INITIATIVE

BE IT ORDAINED, Pursuant to City of Chicago's home rule authority under Article VII, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, by the City Council of the City of Chicago ("City Council") that Title 2, City Government and Administration, Chapter 2-174, Section 2-174-005 through 2-174-030 are hereby inserted into a newly created Article ___, entitled the "City of Chicago Equal Access Initiative" and are thereafter amended and renumbered as follows:

ARTICLE __. CITY OF CHICAGO EQUAL ACCESS INITIATIVE

2-174-005. DECLARATION OF POLICY.

It is the policy of the City of Chicago (the "City") to provide equal employment opportunities to all qualified persons without regard to their race, religion, color, age, disability, sex, national origin, sexual orientation, marital status, membership in the military reserves, creed, ancestry, arrest or conviction record, or use or nonuse of lawful products away from work. In adhering to this policy, the City complies with the Illinois Human Rights Act, Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, and other applicable statutes and regulations relating to equal employment opportunities. The City Council hereby declares that the City of Chicago is a Majority Minority City where almost 62% of the City's population and therefore taxpayers are minority -- African Americans make up 32.9% of the City's population and Hispanics make up 28.9% of the City's population. The City is an employer that values the diversity of its employees and as such seeks to achieve the goal of hiring and maintaining an overall City workforce of 60% minority in every City department including the Chicago Police Department and Chicago Fire Department. This policy represents the City's commitment to a nondiscriminatory work environment for all qualified applicants and employees.

2-174-010. **DEFINTIONS.**

In this Article __ entitled "City of Chicago Equal Access Initiative" --

discrimination resulting in a competitive disadvantage or decreased opportunities to do business with the City.

2-174-015. OFFICE OF DIVERSITY AND OUTREACH.

There is established an Office of Diversity and Outreach that shall be budgeted as a department under the Department of Human Resources and shall maintain at least ten (10) full time equivalents ("FTE"), office space and all other reasonable expenditures needed for the purpose of promoting the importance, benefit and necessity of maintaining diversity within the City's workforce and ensuring compliance with applicable policies, ordinances, statutes, laws and executive orders. With the express goal of achieving an overall City workforce of 60% minority, this Office shall have the following authority and duties pertinent thereto, including but not limited to:

- a. Reviewing and assisting the development of diversity, equal employment opportunity, equal access initiative plans of the various City departments including the Chicago Police Department and the Chicago Fire Department to ensure that each plan is consistent with the overall City plan.
- b. Maintaining and reporting to the City Council on a quarterly basis statistics, which include, but are not limited to, the proportion of underrepresented group members at all levels and job classifications in the City's workforce and the availability of qualified underrepresented group members in the labor force of the relevant labor areas. The statistics shall indicate how each group has been affected by new hires, training opportunities, promotions, discipline and terminations. A presentation should be made to City Council on February 1st of every year.
- c. Counseling employees, managers and others about diversity, equal employment opportunity and equal access initiative issues in the workplace.
 - d. Facilitating diversity related training programs and workplace mediation.
- e. Receiving and investigating complaints of discriminatory employment practices, workplace violence, or of harassment in the workplace from City employees. If an investigation discloses a violation has occurred, the Diversity and Outreach Officer as herein defined shall work with department chiefs, department heads, and managers to implement corrective action and resolve the situation.
- f. Receiving and filing investigating complaints with the City's Inspector General regarding any employee or applicant who believes that he or she has been discriminated against by the City.
- g. Identifying and maintaining comprehensive and effective recruitment methods that promote a diverse workforce.
 - h. Monitoring results of all training, with emphasis on minority recruits.

- i. Participating in performance examinations, job fairs, and recruitment activities at high schools, universities, law schools, chambers of commerce and other locations.
- j. Reviewing all State of Illinois and federal laws, rules and regulations concerning equal employment opportunities to ensure compliance.
- k. Direct participation in the hiring, termination and promotion of each employee of the City including employees of the Chicago Police Department and the Chicago Fire Department to determine whether such hiring, termination or promotion is promoting this Ordinance's goal of achieving an overall City workforce of 60% minority.

2-174-020. DIVERSITY AND OUTREACH OFFICER.

The Mayor of the City of Chicago with the advice and consent of a majority of the City Council shall appoint the Diversity and Outreach Officer to a term of six (6) years. The Diversity and Outreach Officer may be removed by a majority vote of the City Council. The Diversity and Outreach Officer shall manage the day-to-day operations of the Office of Diversity and Outreach; perform complaint intake functions; investigate complaints; serve as the City's Americans with Disabilities Act coordinator; directly participate in the hiring, termination and promotion of each employee of the City including employees of Chicago Police Department and Chicago Fire Department; ensure compliance with applicable ordinances, statutes, laws and executive orders; have responsibility and authority for the development and implementation of a comprehensive diversity, equal employment opportunity and equal access initiative plan for the City including the Chicago Police Department and the Chicago Fire Department; and function as the liaison between the City and the media and the community.

2-174-025. DEPARTMENT DIVERSITY, EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY AND EQUAL ACCESS INITIATIVE PLANS.

Beginning thirty (30) days after the effective date of this Ordinance, each City department including the Chicago Police Department and the Chicago Fire Department shall submit and present to the City Council and the Diversity and Outreach Officer its present racial employment make-up and its diversity, equal employment opportunity and equal access initiative plan to achieve in their department or offices (including the Chicago Police Department and the Chicago Fire Department) a workforce of 60% minority. Thereafter, each City department including the Chicago Police Department and the Chicago Fire Department shall submit and present every year to the City Council and the Diversity and Outreach Officer its racial make-up for that fiscal year and its diversity, equal employment opportunity and equal access initiative plan to achieve in their department including the Chicago Police Department and the Chicago Fire Department a workforce of 60% minority.

2-174-030. IMPLEMENTATION.

- a. Recruitment. In collaboration with the Diversity and Outreach Officer, the Director of Human Resources shall practice comprehensive and inclusive advertising and recruiting efforts, which may include special recruiting targeting previously underrepresented groups in addition to traditional recruiting methods (with great emphasis on identifying qualified minority candidates to serve in Chicago Police Department and Chicago Fire Department), and report such recruitment findings to the City Council every year.
- b. Training. In collaboration with the Diversity and Outreach Officer, the Director of Human Resources shall develop training plans and programs, including on-the-job training, designed to develop the knowledge, skills and abilities essential for developing each employee's fullest potential. The Diversity and Outreach Officer shall develop and provide relevant training to each City department including the Chicago Police Department and Chicago Fire Department to increase employees' knowledge and awareness of laws and regulations, as well as the City's policies relating to diversity, equal employment opportunity, equal access initiative and respecting diversity in the workplace. The Director of Human Resources shall report their training findings to the City Council each year.
- c. Testing, Selection, Placement and Promotion. The Diversity and Outreach Officer shall review the City testing, selection, placement and promotion polices of each department including Chicago Police Department and Chicago Fire Department to ensure that they comply with applicable laws and regulations relating to the goal achieving a workforce consisting of 60% minority.
- d. Union Contracts. The Office of Diversity and Outreach Diversity shall review every existing union contract of each department of each bargaining unit including Chicago Police Department and Chicago Fire Department to ensure that each contract complies with applicable laws and regulations relating to the goal of achieving a workforce consisting of 60% minority. The Diversity and Outreach Officer shall have the authority to terminate any union contract that fails to meet the herein stated goals.

SECTION 1. Section 9-68-020 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by deleting the language struck through and by inserting the language underscored, as follows,

9-68-020 Residential parking permits.

(Omitted text is not affected by this ordinance)

(b-1) Upon application and payment of the required fee to the city clerk, the clerk or his designee shall issue one annual residential parking permit placard (for purposes of this subsection, "placard") to any alderman. The placard shall be issued in such format that enables easy transferability from one vehicle to another vehicle, and it must include the ward's number and a unique identification number. The placard can be used to park any vehicle in any residential parking permit zone in the alderman's ward or in any ward adjacent to the alderman's ward when such vehicle is used by the alderman or his aldermanic staff for the performance of official city business. When in use, the placard must be conspicuously displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle. The fee for issuing a placard shall be \$200.00 per year. Any alderman or his aldermanic staff shall immediately report to the city clerk the loss or theft of any placard. A misuse of a residential parking placard by any alderman or his aldermanic staff shall be deemed to be a violation of Section 2-156-060 of this Code. In addition to any applicable penalty, any person who uses a false, lost, stolen or altered placard shall be fined not less than \$500.00 nor more than \$1,000.00 for each offense.

(Omitted text is not affected by this ordinance)

(f) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b-1) of this section, it It shall be unlawful for any person to affix, cause to be affixed, or otherwise display any residential parking permit or other vehicle-specific permit issued pursuant to any other parking permit program to any automobile other than the vehicle to which the permit was intended to be affixed at the time of issuance by the city.

(Omitted text is not affected by this ordinance)

(j) Except as otherwise provided in subsections (b-1) and (g) of this section, any person violating any of the provisions of this section shall be fined not less than \$200.00 nor more than \$500.00 for each offense, and each day such a violation continues shall be deemed a separate and distinct offense.



ORDINANCE

STORMWATER STRESS FEE

WHEREAS, the City of Chicago is a home rule unit of government as defined in Article VII, Section 6 (a) of the Illinois Constitution, and, as such, may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs.

WHEREAS, stormwater is the only major infrastructure system in the City that is currently not paid for through user fees.

WHEREAS, more than \$773 million was paid out in over 181,000 flood related insurance claims in Cook County between 2007 and 2011. And whereas, 10 of the 23 zip codes with the highest number of aggregated claims also fell within the ZIP codes with the highest levels of impervious surface.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CHICAGO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Purpose.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to provide a stormwater stress user fee for water users in the City of Chicago. To the extent that the provisions of this Ordinance conflict with any prior Ordinance or provision of the City, this Ordinance shall control.

Section 2. Definitions.

SECTION 1. Chapter 11-12 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is amended by adding a new Section 11-12-325, as follows:

11-12-325 Stormwater Stress Fee

(a) As used in this section:

"City" means the City of Chicago.

"Impervious Surface" means a surface which substantially precludes the infiltration of water, such as concrete, asphalt, tile or compacted gravel.

"Eligible properties" means properties that are currently billed by the Department of Water Management for water and sewer services.

<u>"Fee" means a monthly stormwater stress user fee to be added to eligible properties' monthly water bills.</u>

(b) The Department of Water Management is authorized to establish and administer a stormwater stress fee program under this section. Under this program, owners whose properties meet the eligibility requirements for stormwater stress fee collection may be charged a fee in the amount specified in Section 3.

Section 3-1 <u>Method of Computing and Reflecting Stormwater Stress for Residential</u> <u>Properties</u>

Commencing in 2017, the City will collect a monthly stormwater stress fee on eligible properties.

The Department of Water Management will be responsible for auditing the sewer fund and determining exactly how much of the sewer fund is allocated annually towards stormwater management.

The Department of Water Management will determine the median square feet of impervious surface area for single family homes in the city. This shall be defined as an "equivalent residential unit" (ERU) and will be the base billing unit for the stormwater stress fee.

<u>The Department of Water Management will set a billing rate for single-family detached residences and single-family attached residences that will be calculated as follows:</u>

SWM_R / ERU_R

Where:

<u>SWM_R</u> = Annual Stormwater Management Cost for all single-family detached and single-family attached residential properties in the City of Chicago

<u>ERU_R = Equivalent Residential Units for all single-family detached residences and single-family attached residences in the City of Chicago</u>

Thus, if the annual stormwater management cost for all single-family detached and single-family attached residential properties in the City of Chicago was determined to be \$10,000,000 and it is determined that there are 500,000 ERUs for all single-family detached residences and single-family attached residences in the city, the rate for the stormwater stress fee would be \$20 per ERU. Single-family detached residences and single-family attached residences will all be assumed to have an ERU of 1.0 and their fee will be assessed accordingly.

Section 3-2 <u>Method of Computing and Reflecting Stormwater Stress for Non-Residential</u> Properties

<u>Properties other than single-family detached residences and single-family attached residences</u> will be charged a stormwater stress fee that will be calculated as follows:

SWM_c / ERU_c

Where:

<u>SWM_C</u> = Annual Stormwater Management Cost for all non single-family detached and single-family attached residential properties in the City of Chicago

 ERU_C = Equivalent Residential Units for all non single family detached residens and single-family attached residences in the entirety of the City of Chicago

Thus, if the stormwater management cost for all non single-family detached and single-family attached residential properties in the city was determined to be \$40,000,000 and it is determined that there are 5,000,000 ERUs for all non single-family detached residences and single-family attached residences in the city, the rate for the stormwater stress fee would be \$8 per ERU.

<u>Properties other than single-family detached residences and single-family attached residences will then be charged a stormwater stress fee at the corresponding rate set by the Department of Water Management for each ERU, or fraction thereof, of impervious surface area of the property. (Example: a property consisting of 25,000 ft² of which 10,000 ft² is impervious would pay a stormwater stress fee</u>

computed as follows: 10,000 ft² of impervious surface divided by an ERU of 2,000 ft² equals 5.0; the 5.0 ERU is then multiplied by the rate set by the Department of Water Management.)

Section 4. <u>Implementation, Eligibility and Enforcement</u>

The Department of Water Management of the City of Chicago will assess which properties are subject to fee collection. They will work with the Department of Innovation and Technology to use their Geographic Information Systems program to assess the square footage of impervious surface area on eligible properties in Chicago.

A portion of the fees collected under this ordinance will be used towards implementing the stormwater stress fee program. The remaining funds will be deposited into the sewer fund. The amount in fees deposited into the sewer fund will be deducted from the total amount of funds currently collected under the sewer billing system. This will be reflected by an according decrease in the sewer bill as a percentage of the water bill.

Owners of eligible properties will be held to the liability standards as defined under section 11-12-330 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago. All fees are to be enforced as specified in Chapter 11-12, Article V of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago.

Section 5. Section 3-12-020 of Title 3 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language as follows:

3-12-020 Charge for Sewer Service and Use of Sewerage System.

(a) A charge for sewer service and use of the sewerage system of the City of Chicago is hereby established. The charge shall be an amount equal to the percentage set forth in the below Table, of the amount charged for water service pursuant to Chapter 11-12 of this Code, whether such water service is metered or otherwise. The percentages established in the below Table are subject to change when the sewer fund is subsidized by fees collected by the stormwater stress fee program. Provided, however, that:

(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance.)

Section 6. Appeals

The Department of Water Management will develop an application form and application process for appeals to the assessed stormwater fee on a property, incorporating requirements as are necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance.

Any owner may file an application with the Department of Water Management contesting the calculation of impervious surface area on the lot as of the date of the application. The applicant must submit satisfactory evidence as required by the Department of Water Management, such as square footage measurements and descriptions of the relevant buildings or materials.

Section 7. Exemptions

Exemptions for sewer fees governed under Section 11-12-540 and Section 3-12-050 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago will also be made applicable to the stormwater stress fee. The Department of Water Management will develop an application process for these exceptions, incorporating requirements as are necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance.

Section 8. User Credits

Owners of properties subject to Chapter 11-18 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago will be eligible for user credits to offset a portion of their assessed stormwater stress fee. The Department of Water Management will prepare an ordinance, for submission to the City Council, which determines a credits program and an application process for the credits program. Credits given to owners of properties subject to Chapter 11-18 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago will be capped at 20% of the assessed stormwater stress fee.

Section 9. Review

The Commissioner of the Department Water Management shall perform an audit of the program one year after it has been enacted. The audit will include an analysis of single-family detached residences' and single-family attached residences' water utility expenses prior to and after the enactment of the program. This analysis will also forecast single-family detached residences' and single-family attached residences' projected water utility expenses from that point forward.

Section 10.

The ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

The rate of the tax shall be equal to nine percent of the admission fees or other charges paid for the privilege to enter, to witness, to view or to participate in such amusement, unless subsection E of this section provides for a lower rate.
- B. The tax imposed by subsection A shall not apply to the following persons or privileges:

(g)—societies or organizations conducted for the sole purpose of maintaining symphony orchestras, opera performances or artistic presentations, including, but not limited to, musical presentations ("artistic societies or organizations"), if the artistic society or organization (i) receives substantial support from voluntary contributions, (ii) is a not-for-profit institution where no part of the net earnings inure to the benefit of any private shareholder or person, and (iii) either (a) bears all risk of financial loss from its presentation of the amusement and the amusement is limited to an engagement of not more than eight calendar days over the course of a calendar year or (b) is substantially and materially involved in the production and performance of the amusement. Where an amusement is sponsored or conducted by two or more artistic societies or organizations, the requirements of subsections (i) and (ii) of this subsection 4-156-020(B)(5)(g) must be met by each of such artistic societies or organizations, but the requirements of subsection (iii) may be met by any of such artistic societies or organizations, individually or in combination.

(g) any admission to symphony orchestras, opera performances or artistic presentations, including, but not limited to, musical presentations ("artistic societies or organizations"), if admission to such performances is purchased by or facilitated by the Chicago Public Schools or the Chicago Park District for the benefit of children enrolled in public schools or park district programs.
