

EXECUTIVE ORDER 87-3

WHEREAS, while executive and legislative initiatives relating to the Advisory Commission on Latino Affairs are currently under review, the important work undertaken by the Advisory Commission on Latino Affairs should continue without interruption; now, therefore

I, HAROLD WASHINGTON, Mayor of the City of Chicago in the State of Illinois do hereby declare and order as follows:


SECTION 1. The Mayor's Advisory Commission on Latino Affairs, established by Executive Order 85-4, is hereby extended to March 15, 1988.
